


## ROLLER SHADE ADJUSTMENT INSTRUCTIONS




## **Upper Stop Adjustment**

To <u>lower</u> the upper stopping point, rotate the <u>clear</u> knob clockwise. To <u>raise</u> the upper stopping point, rotate <u>clear</u> knob counter-clockwise.

## **Speed Control**

To <u>increase</u> the speed of the shade, rotate the <u>black</u> knob clockwise.


To <u>decrease</u> the speed of the shade, rotate the <u>black</u> knob counter-clockwise.






## Fixing an Over-Extended Roller Shade




Irvine Shade & Door roller shades utilize a smooth-operating tension/speed reduction system. A shade can become over-extended and will not retract. If this occurs, the shade may become stuck in the down position. There is a very simple fix to allow the spring to reengage and operate normally.



As you are facing the roller shade in its down position, locate the dial on the left end of the shade tube.



Grasp the dial on the left side and turn the tube 1 complete rotation in the CLOCKWISE direction. This will allow 1 layer of material to wrap around the roller tube.



Reactivate the normal spring operation of the roller shade with a firm tug on the bottom rail. The shade will raise into the up position. Your shade will now operate normally.
