Winter Shut-Down Procedures

Important: Filter Housings will break if water is left in them in freezing weather conditions.

The following procedure is recommended if you are winterizing your RV.

- 1. Shut off the water supply to the filter system.
- 2. Relieve pressure from the water system by turning on cold water in shower and kitchen. Leave open during procedure.
- 3. Remove the filter housing by turning counter clockwise.
- Slide out the old filter and discard.
 O-rings should be saved for future use.
- 5. Empty excess water from the filter housing and reinstall by turning clockwise.
- 6. Close cold water valves and proceed with winterizing the rv.
