MENU: Press to display the OSD menu, Press again to exit the menu.


SOURCE: Press to select the input source of the TV.

STANDBY: Press to turn the unit on or off.





e Guest Remote Control - R230D1A

remote is used by the hotel guest. It prevents the guest from changing configuration settings. To change the settings of the TV, refer to the Master Remote.



1. POWER

Switches the set on or off.

Initial Setup Wizard

After connecting your TV antenna or cable wire, turn the television ON. The quick setup wizard will display on-screen. Select your preferred Picture setting followed by antenna options if you will view local over-the-air TV broadcasts from an antenna. These channels will be stored in the TV tuner memory after performing Channel Auto Scan.

Select Language

Press **◄/▶** button to select the language to be used for menus and message.

Press ▼/▲ button to select go to next step and press OK/▶ button to go.



Select Time

Press ▼/▲ button to select the time zone, daylight saving time and time format you want.

Press **◄/▶** button on the remote control to adjust.

Press ▼/▲ button on the remote control to select go to next step and press OK/▶ button to go.

Auto Scan

Press **◄**/**▶** button to select the antenna type.

Press ▼/ ▲ button to select go to next step.

Press OK/► button to start auto scan. Channels found will be stored into the TV tuner memory.



Adjust the hue (Red, Green, Blue) of the picture.

Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Sharpness

Press ◀ / ▶ button to adjust.

Color Temperature

Adjust the color personality of the picture to your preference.

Normal - Gives the white colors a neutral tint.

Warm - Gives the white colors a reddish tint.

Cool - Gives the white colors a bluish tint.





Audio Languages

AVL maintains a consistent sound level set by the viewer regardless of the channel or program.







Over Scan

Press **◄/▶** button to select(On/Off).

Input Label






[Commercial Mode]

Turn on or off the commercial mode.

[Boot Setting]


Opens sub-menu that allows the user to configure various commercial settings for the television.



- A) Picture Mode Set the default picture mode that the customer would like each time the TV is powered on.
- B) Default Volume Set the initial volume level of the television for power on.
- C) Max Volume This feature allows the user to set a maximum volume level for the TV.
- D) Boot Source Selection determines what state the TV is upon power on.
- **E)** Boot Channel (not selectable unless 'Boot Source' is set to TV) Allows the user to tell the TV if they would like the channel to power up to a specific channel when the TV is powered on.
- **F)** Channel Select (not selectable unless 'Boot Channel' is selected) Opens a sub menu that allows the user to specify what channel they want the TV to tune to when the unit is powered on.

[Commercial Lock]

Sub menu that allows the user to lock out a variety of functions on the television.



- A) TUNER LOCK Enabling this lock feature prevents the user from being able to alter the channel lineup on the television by running a channel scan.
- B) KEYPAD LOCK Enabling this lock feature prevents the user from using the console buttons to control the television.
- C) MENU LOCK Enabling this lock feature prevents the user from using the on-screen menu to control the television.

[Power Save]

Sets the amount of time the TV sits idle with no button push or remote control commands received before powering off.

[TV To USB] (requires the USB Flash Drive to be inserted in the USB port on the television)

This option exports the current television configuration (channel listings and commercial settings) to a USB flash drive for cloning purposes. (This can be used to bypass setting up each individual television manually)

Note: Upon successful completion of coping the current configuration, the television will power off.

[USB To TV] (requires the USB Flash drive used for EXPORT to be inserted in the USB Port on the television)

Selecting this option will restore previously saved configuration (channel listings and commercial settings) to the television to ensure that all televisions on the property are configured identical.

Note: upon successful completion of restortion of the configuration file, the television will power off.

****IMPORTANT: TV To USB/USB To TV options will only work with LIKE model televisions. If you have different sizes/models, each style will require it's own USB FLASH DRIVE****

[On/Off Timer]

This option can be used to set a daily timer to turn the TV on or off automatically (useful for lobbies or other public viewing areas).

[Audio Output]

This option can be used to set Audio output.

Press **◄/▶** button to select.

[Info Show]

This option can be used to set Info show.

Press **◄/▶** button to select.

[Reset Commercial]

Executing this command will reset all commercial features contained within the Commercial Menu to their factory default settings.



Troubleshooting

Carry out the problem-solving measures described in the following section before contacting Customer Support.

Turn off the device immediately as soon as you suspect a malfunction and unplug the power plug.

Do not attempt to repair the device yourself.

SYMPTOM	CHECK ITEM
LED screen stays dark.	Make sure the unit is turned on and the connections are correct.
There is no sound.	Make sure the system connection is correct. Make sure the power of speakers is turned on.
There is no picture or picture move up and down unsteady.	Check if the connections with the external AV signal source are correct. Correctly set the items in the picture menu. Check if the video type input signal is not corresponding to the unit. Make sure the unit is turned on and in correct video type.
The remote control does not work.	Make sure there no obstructions between the remote control and the unit. Make sure the remote control is pointing at the unit. Make sure the batteries are inserted or the polarity is correct. Make sure the batteries are not weak. Replace the weak battery.

Other Notes:

Static or other external interfere may cause the player to behave abnormally. In this occurs, unplug the power-supply cord from the outlet and plug it in again to reset the player.

If the problems persist, then please disconnect the power and consult a manufacturer.
