

10. Power Lines

11. Overloading

Do not overload wall outlets and extension cords as this can result in a risk of fire or electric shock.

12. Object and Liquid Entry

Never push objects of any kind into this TV through openings as they may touch dangerous voltage points or short-out parts that could result in a fire or electric shock. Never spill liquid of any kind on or inside the TV.

13. Servicing

Black box on screen	 The "Text" option is enabled and no text is available. Press the CCD button on the remote control to turn off. See page 8.
No power	Batteries in the remote control may need replacing. Re-attach AC plug to wall outlet.
No picture	 Digital TV channel signal maybe weak, try another channel. Press INPUT button to verify the desired input selected. Re-connect the antenna or cable wiring.
Remote control does not function	 Replace batteries with new ones. Check that battery polarity is correct. Point remote directly at the TV's IR receiver. See page 10.
